Section 605.14. Change in Title.—Registration. Where the title of any real estate is finally established or is passed by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment of the county court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, conveyance, or otherwise, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
