Section 9361. Change in Title. — Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment of the supreme court, or by a judgment of the court is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
