Section 606, K. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is found to have been changed by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, or order of a court, the county auditor shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
