Section 6061k. Change in Title.— Certification. Where the title of any real estate is transferred by deed, or by judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by any other means, the auditor of the county in charge of the office of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
