Section 6061k. Change in Title.—Classification. Where the title of any property is changed by any person or person by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred by a deed, mortgage, or other instrument, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
