Section 665.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title to land is changed by a deed, mortgage or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred by a deed, mortgage or judgment, or in any other case, the clerk of the district court shall certify, at the same time the deed, mortgage or judgment is filed, the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
