Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding, or by decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or contract, and the same is not of record in the county auditor's office, the auditor, under the seal of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
