Section 6814. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment, decree, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the court, or the county auditor, in the county in which said land is located:
