Section 6614. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county auditor, and such title is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of record, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor, and the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
