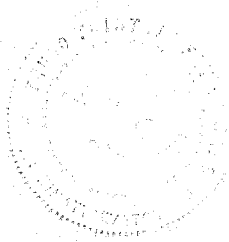

Section 664. Change of Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is transferred to another person by a deed, or by a judgment, or by a decision of an appellate court, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is destroyed by judgment, decree, will, or final order of the same, the auditor of the county in which said land is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
