Section 603.1. Change in Title. Certificate. Where the name of any person or persons is changed or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or whose title to real estate is changed by a judgment or decree of the district court, or who produce, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
