Section 636.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the court of appeals, the same shall be changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify, on the same day as the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order is made, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
