Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment, decree, or order of a court of record, or by a final decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of record, or by a final decision of an appellate court, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located:
