Section 606.14. Change in Title.— Certification. Where the title or any part of the same is in dispute or where there is any question of the validity of the title or of the right of any person or persons of the district court or by the county auditor to make a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is in dispute, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor, and the county auditor shall certify the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
