Section 6981A. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court, same shall be recorded in the public records of the county in which same is situated. By judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
