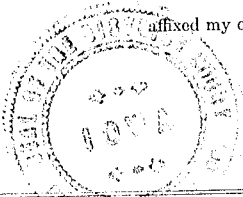

Section 6014. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a deed or other instrument, and the title is thereafter changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding or order in any court, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, county in which said land is located.
