Section 636.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any case by a court of record, or by a final judgment, decree, or order, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or otherwise, the county auditor shall certify the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
