Section 8914. Change in Title.—Confirmation. Where the title of any real estate finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a deed of record, shall have been taken to real estate in the hands of the county auditor, and the same is changed by judgment of court, or by deed of record, and the auditor is notified by the clerk of the district court that the same is changed, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, county in which said land is located.
