Section 60614. Change in Title. -- Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction or a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of competent jurisdiction, the auditor of the county in which the land is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
