Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person by a judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court of this state, or by a final order of judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of said court shall certify the same under the seal of said court to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
