Section 6834. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to any real estate is transferred to any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred to any person or persons by a deed or other instrument in writing, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
