Section 606.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title to any real estate is changed by deed or by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred by a deed or by a judgment or decree of a probate court, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
