Section 666.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the courts and entry is made thereon, or where the title is finally established by a deed, or where the title is finally established by a conveyance, or where the title is finally established by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify to the auditor of the county in which said land is located.

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
