Section 606.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is transferred in any or by any means, the county auditor shall certify to the effect of a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or otherwise, the county auditor shall certify to the effect of the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
