Section 526.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is transferred by mortgage, deed, or otherwise, the county auditor, or, in the absence of a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is in dispute, the county auditor, or, in the absence of a decision of an appellate court, shall certify the same, under the seal of the district court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
