Section 606.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally determined by a court of record, or by a court of the district court or by a justice of the peace, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, or other legal process, the auditor of the county in which said estate, title, or interest is located, shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
