Section 606, H. — Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate or interest therein is changed by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, the assessor of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
