

Section 6614. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of a court of record, or by a judgment or decree of a court of record, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, partition, or other in writing, the clerk of the district or county court, or the county auditor, shall file a copy of the same in the county auditor's office, and the county auditor shall issue a certificate of the same.
