Section 686, 14. Change in Title. — Confirmation. Where the name of a person or persons is changed in any person or persons by an judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment of a probate court, and there is no objection to the change of name, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
