Section 006.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed by any person or persons, the title shall be changed by the clerk of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, and the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
