Section 606-14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the original owner of a tract of land is dead, or where the title to the same has been transferred by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
