Section 6361. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the court or judge, will, proceeding, or order in probate, shall certify to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
