Section 6834. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is transferred to another person by a deed, or by a judgment of a court, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or otherwise, the auditor of the county in which the same is located shall certify the same, and the seal of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
