Section 605, i.e. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any land, situated in this county, is changed by a deed, mortgage, or other instrument, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is claimed by adverse parties, the auditor of the county is required to certify to the title of the land, and to the name of the person or persons claiming the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
