Section 6614. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, or a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in proceedings in law or equity, or by any other legal proceeding, the auditor of the county in which said land is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
