Section 6614. Change in Title. Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person or institution or donee of the district court or by the district court, and the same is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of record, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same under the seal of the district court, and the same shall be recorded in the county in which said land is located.
