Section 60214. Change in Title. — Confirmation. Where the title of any real estate finally established by or for any person by a judgment or decree of the district court or by its clerk, or by a judgment or decree of the county court or by its clerk, is changed by judgment or decree of the district court or by its clerk, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, together with a copy of the judgment or decree, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
