Section 605.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of competent jurisdiction, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of competent jurisdiction, the clerk of the court, or the judge, or the auditor of the county, to which the title is transferred, shall certify and record the same in the county in which said land is located.
