Section 686.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person by a judgment or decree of the district court or any person or persons, and the title of such real estate is thereafter changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall verify the same, and certify the same to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
