Where the title of any real estate is changed in any person or persons by judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or otherwise, the clerk of the court shall, upon the filing of the certificate of the clerk of the court, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
