Section 8614. Change of Title. - Confirmation. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decree of the supreme court, or by a decree of the district court in a case in which the title is in dispute, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
