Section 636 14. Change in Title. Confirmation. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county court, and the same is entered for taxation, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
