Section 636.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court of the county in which said land is located, shall certify the same to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
