Section 606.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or partition proceedings, or by any other legal proceeding, the county auditor, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
