Section 636, 14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title to land is changed by deed, mortgage, or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or when title to real estate is transferred by any other means, the auditor of the county, upon the production of the original or a certified copy of the instrument, or the decree or decision of the court, shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
