Section 6081A. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county court, and the same is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor, and the county auditor shall certify the same to the county in which said land is located.
