Section 606.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding in the courts of this State, or in any court of record or to a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any such court, the auditor of the county in which the same is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
