Section 606.14. Change in Title—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment, decree, or order of a court of competent jurisdiction, or by a final decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in proceedings in which the title to the land is finally established, the auditor of the county in which said land is located.
