Section 636.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is transferred by deed, mortgage, or other instrument, the title of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, court order, or other instrument, the county auditor shall certify the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
