Section 636.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county court, and the title is thereafter changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of law or equity, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
